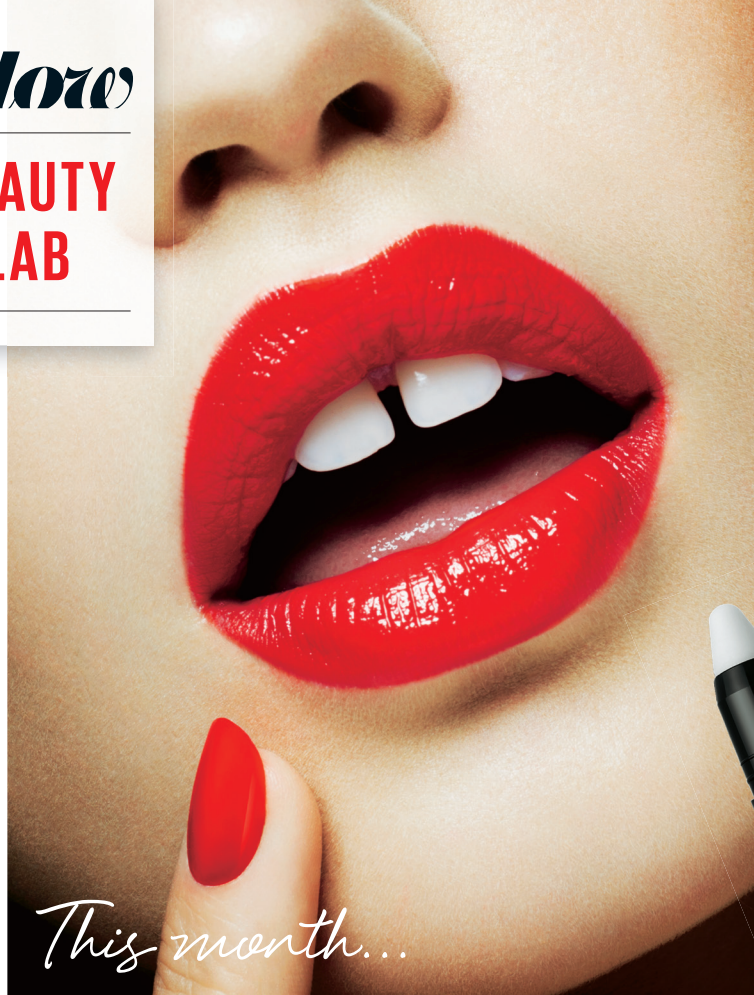
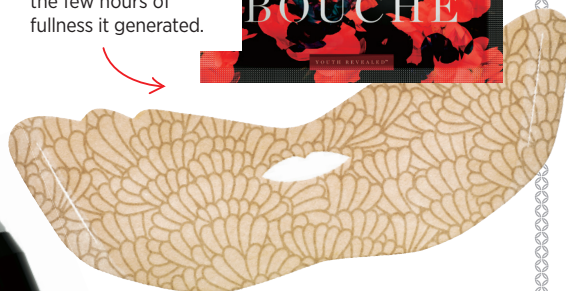



**Nannette De Gaspé
