DUAL-INTENSITY EYESHADOW IN CRESSIDA, £21, NARS

A delicate wash of electric blue around the eyes can appear almost like watercolour.

GEL LAB PRO IN THE PLEASURE PRINCIPLE, £18, DEBORAH LIPPMANN
